MADONNA di CAMPIGLIO, the VILLAGE



Surrounded by the Dolomites, one of the most beautiful mountain ranges in the world and now part of the UNESCO World Natural Heritage list, Madonna di Campiglio (1550m) is an intimate and elegant alpine village located in a breathtaking valley just a couple of hours north of Verona.

Launched as a tourist centre in the second half of the 1800s, today Madonna di Campiglio is one of Italy's best ski destinations as well as one of the most important in the Alps.

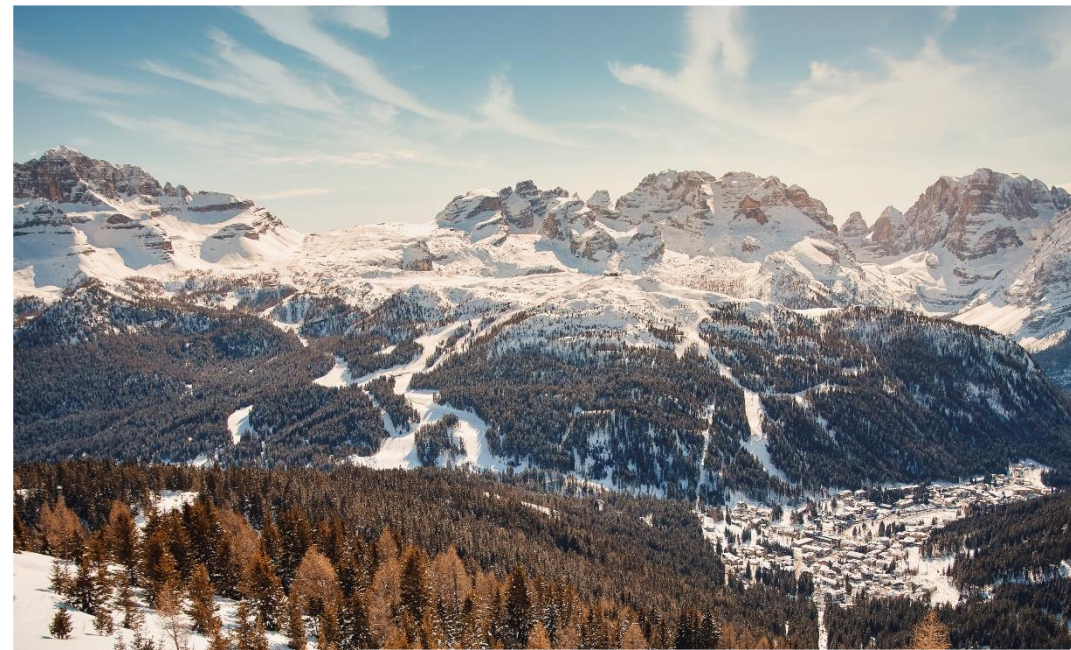
Madonna di Campiglio was much loved by the Austro-Hungarian aristocracy in the 19th century. Princess Sissi and the Emperor Franz Joseph were among its celebrity guests. The village still retains its age-old charm, supported by state-of-the-art facilities.



THE PEARL OF THE DOLOMITES

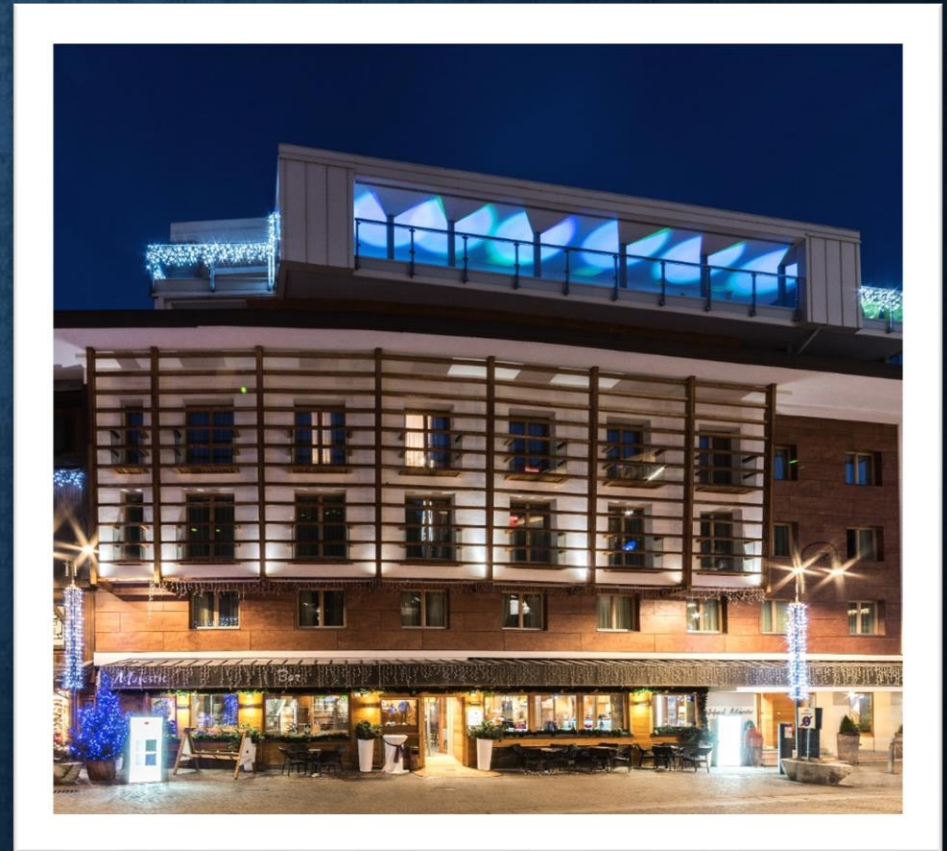

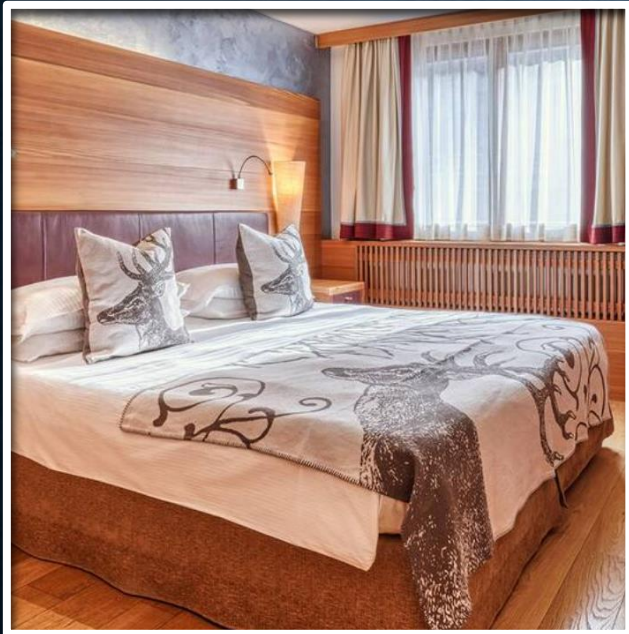
THE CONFERENCE VENUE...THE ELEGANT MAJESTIC MOUNTAIN CHARME HOTEL

- With over 50 years in the hospitality industry, the Maturi family are committed to make every stay an unforgettable one.

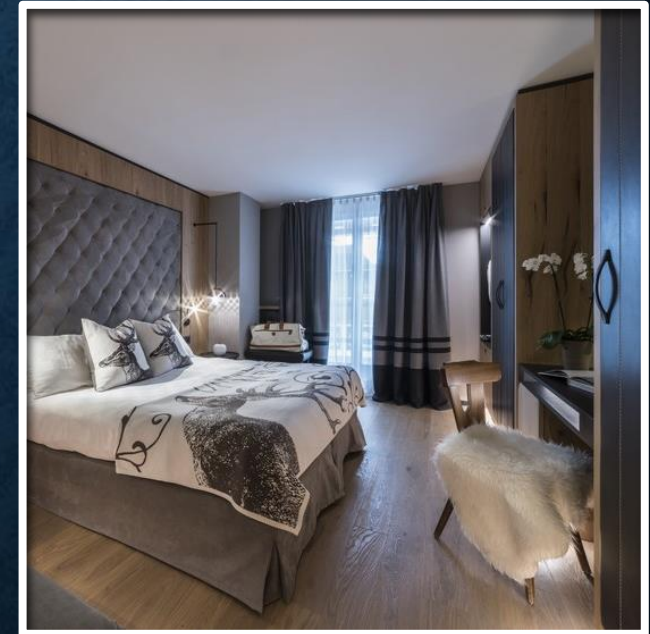

SKIING IN MADONNA DI CAMPIGLIO

The three interconnected ski areas around the villages of Pinzolo, Marilleva, Folgarida and Madonna di Campiglio offer 155 km over 93 mapped ski trails. 59 ultra-modern, fast and reliable lifts (90,000 people per hour) take skiers up to an altitude of 2500m. With a vertical drop of 1300m the runs suit all abilities (45 beginner, 37 intermediate, 18 advanced) and all are accessible directly from the village centre.



The skiing in Campiglio can be as relaxed or as challenging as you wish to make it...and when you want to head home, it's easy. The main runs will take you directly to the village.





A GREAT PLACE FOR THE WHOLE FAMILY

Madonna di Campiglio is a very 'family friendly' ski destination thanks to a wide range of services and ski programs for children of all ages. There are plenty of activities and options for families to choose from.

Kids ski areas: Beginner /kids ski areas are walking distance to the hotel.

Ski schools: there is a variety of specialised kids ski lessons/ programs for children of all ages and abilities. Parents can relax knowing that their children will learn how to ski in a safe and fun environment.

Kids club: For young children (from 3 years of age) full day supervised fun programs run by local ski schools, including ski lessons and outdoor/ indoor activities.

Transfers: Ski schools offer pick up/ drop off service to allow parents' hassle-free ski days.

Plus: Children born after 30 Nov 2014 ski FREE.

Note: Children's ski programs are not included in the conference accommodation & ski package and would be quoted on request.

Besides alpine skiing, the village of Campiglio offers a variety of activities for skiers and non-skiers alike:

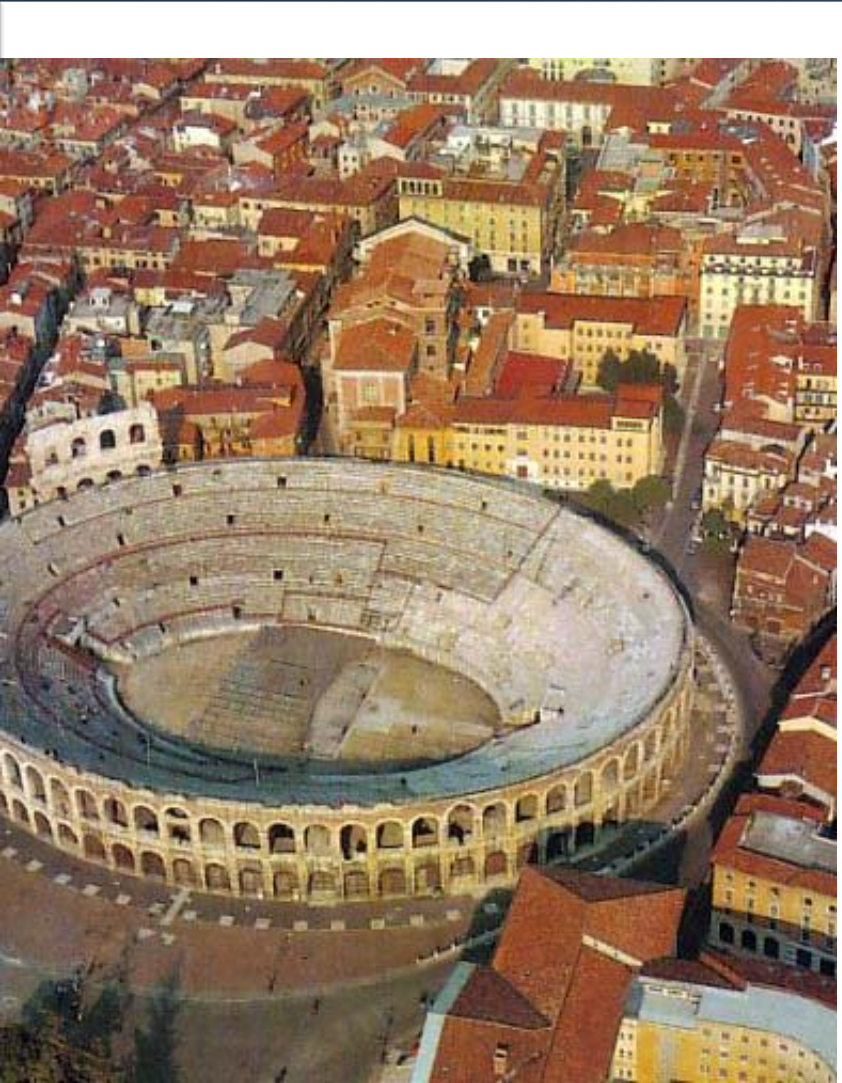

TRAVEL & TRANSFERS



There are a number air travel and gateway city/airport options. The closest cities with an intercontinental airport are Venice (Marco Polo) and Milan (Malpensa), although other cities such as Bergamo (Orio Al Serio), or Verona (Villafranca) are viable alternatives if arriving within Europe.

Group Transfers:

- Wednesday, 8th Jan - A private bus will depart from the Venice Marco Polo Airport at 10.30/11am (tbc) and take delegates and families direct to Majestic Mountain Charme Hotel in Madonna di Campiglio
- Saturday, 18th Jan - At the conclusion of your stay in Campiglio, a private bus will take delegates back to Venice Marco Polo airport (8am tbc)

Private and individual transfers: In addition to the group transfers, we would be pleased to discuss your personal preferences and assist with alternative transfer arrangements.
